DROP OFF / PICK UP

We have changed the design of our drop-off and pick-up circle to start the 20-21 school year. [Please review this diagram](#) to allow for a smooth process each morning and afternoon. **Please stick to the schedule as closely as possible. Classrooms do not open until 8:30 a.m. and our parking lot cannot accommodate everyone who would like to arrive early and wait for their child in the carline in the afternoon. If you would like to arrive early, please park in a space and you can either walk up to the circle to pick up a child or rejoin the carline at the appropriate time.**

As a reminder, these are the dropoff and pickup times:

- 8:30 MS students and siblings arrive
- 8:40 US students and siblings arrive
- 8:45 ES students without older siblings in MS and US arrive
- 1:00 ECC students
- 2:45 US students (Tuesday-Friday)
- 3:00 MS students and ECC aftercare; US students (Mondays only)
- 3:15 K-5 students and MS students with younger siblings

LUNCH

- We'll be finding out more in the coming weeks about Lunches for Kids (Cutthroat Café) and Lunches for our Teachers.
- We're exploring the idea of each class providing a lunch once a month for their class teacher... more on this soon.
