A candidate for the Sun Valley Community School Teacher Training Academy (TTA) Program needs to complete all of the following requirements and send them electronically to the TTA Administrator. All requirements must be included in order for **the application to be complete and ready for revision by the hiring committee.**

1. A professional cover letter to the TTA Administrator expressing your interests in the internship and the school.
2. A detailed resume that includes your employment, education, certifications, and interests.
3. Two or more letters of recommendation, one from an employer and one from an educator or college professor who knows your work.
4. College transcripts (only legible copies accepted).
5. This application, typed, completed, signed, and dated.

Interviews

Once you complete and submit this application and all required documents, the Sun Valley Community School TTA Administrator will contact you to let you know the progress of your application. The next step in the application process will be video chat interviews with a select group of semifinalists combined with reference checks. After the video chat interviews, the school will notify each of the semifinalists about the next step in the process. Sun Valley Community School encourages finalists to visit the school and interview in person at the candidate's expense. Following the video chat interviews, finalists will receive paperwork to complete for a criminal background check, which is standard for all work with children. Once the school receives the results of your criminal background check, final notice of acceptance to the 2019-20 TTA Cohort will be sent with a contract of employment. Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis. The final deadline for application submission is **March 15, 2019**.

February - April

- * Initial review of applicants as materials are received
- * Video chat interviews for select candidates scheduled early April

mid-April - May

- * School calls references of select candidates
- * Application review and follow-up contact by school's administration
- * Finalists selected and internship offers extended
- * Finalists must send in the background check paperwork
- * School sends interns their contract of employment

August

- *Monday, the third week of August - Teacher Training Academy Orientation starts, including internship, school programs, outdoor program, and residential life orientations
 - ***Please note that all interns must arrive before the first Monday of the third week of August!**
